JEADI Course List

The Honors College JEADI Committee keeps a running list of approved JEADI courses and updates the approved course list every semester at the beginning of September and February. The courses are approved for five years and the JEADI committee will maintain oversight of this course list.

Students must take the Honors College course within the approved timeframe for the course to be eligible to apply towards the JEADI Distinction.

Please note that JEADI courses are not offered every semester, so students should plan accordingly during their Honors College experience to take courses from the JEADI course list.

Explanation of Start and End Semester Codes:

These are codes used by UNM to indicate the academic year and semester #'s (Spring = 10, Summer = 60, Fall = 80).

Examples:

Spring 2023 = 202310

Summer 2024 = 202460

Fall 2025 = 202580

Critical Analyses of U.S. and Global Cultures (CAC) Course List

Students should refer to the [CAC course list](#) on UNM's General Education website for approved courses. Students must take the CAC course within the approved timeframe for the course to be eligible to apply towards the JEADI Distinction.

JEADI Distinction Requirements

- 12 credit hours
- At least 9 credit hours must be from UHON/HNRS approved course list
- 3 credit hours can be from the Critical Analyses of U.S. and Global Cultures (CAC) list or UHON/HNRS
- 3 credit hours of the 12 credit hours must be upper division
- These courses do not need to be in addition to coursework already completed for Honors degree
- Students must complete one of the four Honors degree pathways in order to earn the JEADI distinction
